

### Teen/Artist Project 2014-2015 Internship Application

The Modern Art Museum of Fort Worth's education department is accepting intern applications for the Teen/Artist Project (T/AP). This program is a special, in-depth series of classes for high school students who want to learn more about art with artists as teachers. The 2014-2015 T/AP runs from September 2014 through April 2015. Classes meet in the Museum studio on most Sundays from 2 to 5 pm, and interns are expected to attend every class meeting. Up to fifteen students are selected to participate in the program each year; they work with five different artists over the course of the series, exploring artwork in the galleries and creating their own work in the studio. The program ends in May of 2015 with a juried exhibition of the students' work at a local gallery.

#### Intern Responsibilities:

- be available from 1:30 to 5:15 pm every Sunday during the program, per the schedule below
- keep track of student attendance each week
- locate and set up studio materials for each class
- assist visiting artists with projects; help students throughout the class
- assist with cleanup after each session
- send weekly T/AP student e-mail
- document the program via photographs with Museum equipment
- write T/AP blog posts
- assist in preparations for the annual exhibition in May
- be available on the weekends (during gallery hours) for the duration of the T/AP exhibition

Teen/Artist Project intern opportunities are open to energetic and committed adults, age 18 and older (who have graduated from high school), with an interest in art and mentoring teens. Experience in artmaking is a necessity and an interview is required. The T/AP internship is a paid position.
